



GROUP A: RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

1. Excellence in Research Award

Description: This award honors researchers who excel in advancing knowledge, publishing high-quality research, and influencing their field, industry, or society.

Criteria:

1. Eligibility

- Nominees must not serve on the award selection committee.

2. Ethics and Professional Conduct

- Demonstrates high moral and ethical standards, positive collaboration, and commitment to professional growth.

3. Research Excellence

- Publishes at least 3 peer-reviewed articles in the current year, with at least one in a high-impact journal (e.g., Scopus Q1/Q2).
- Achieved a cumulative total of 20 indexed publications over their career.

4. Research Grants and Funding

- Secures at least one competitive research grant in the current year.
- Led research projects with funding exceeding USD 30,000 (or equivalent) within the past three years.

5. Research Influence

- Maintains an h-index of at least 10 or annual citations exceeding 200.
- Provides evidence of impact on policy, industry standards, or best practices with supporting documents (e.g., policy briefs or testimonials).

2. Excellence in Research Collaboration Award

Description: This award recognizes individuals or teams that have conducted advanced research through outstanding collaborations across institutions, disciplines, or sectors and have significantly impacted Shinawatra University.

Criteria:

1. Eligibility

- Nominees must not serve on the award selection committee.

2. Ethics and Professional Conduct

- Demonstrates substantial ethical conduct, collaborative professionalism, and dedication to fostering partnerships.

3. Collaboration Impact

- Organized at least 3 conferences or symposiums annually, each involving over 100 participants.
- Presents at least 5 research papers annually at national or international conferences.

4. Research Outcomes

- Produces impactful joint publications or projects that address societal, scientific, or technological challenges.

5. Institutional Contributions

- Collaborates on initiatives that enhance Shinawatra University's visibility, reputation, or academic offerings.

3. Legacy of Excellence in Higher Education Award

***Description:** This award honors educators whose lifelong contributions to teaching, research, and professional development have left a profound legacy in higher education at both national and international levels.*

Criteria:

1. Teaching Dedication

- Minimum 30 years of distinguished teaching service in higher education.

2. Ethics and Professional Conduct

- Exemplifies integrity, professionalism, and commitment to personal and institutional growth.

3. Teaching and Knowledge Creation

- Produces outstanding teaching results and contributes significant knowledge recognized nationally or internationally.

4. Reputation and Leadership

- Earns a distinguished reputation from awards, publications, or institutional achievements.

5. Expert Recommendations

- Endorsed by at least 2 experts in the relevant field for exceptional contributions and influence.

4. Excellence in Innovation and Impact Award

***Description:** This award honors researchers or teams whose innovative work has led to measurable advancements in their field and contributed positively to society or industry.*

Criteria:

1. Eligibility

- Nominees must present work with documented outcomes within the past 5–10 years.

2. Innovation Excellence

- Develop innovative solutions, technologies, or methodologies that redefine existing paradigms.

3. Impact on Society or Industry

- Demonstrates real-world adoption of innovation with documented societal or industrial benefits.

4. Recognition and Sustainability

- Gains recognition through awards or citations and ensures scalability of their innovation.

5. Collaboration for Impact

- Works with government, industry, or nonprofits to maximize the application and relevance of research outcomes.
